DELAMERE FOREST LIVE CONCERTS 2025

I'm writing to let you know some details about our Forest Live Concerts this summer.

Like previous years, we'll be using the main Visitor Centre car parks and fields as well as Coronation Farm for car parking. The drop-off/pick-point will be located in Whitefield Car Park off Station Road using two entrances, the main Whitefield entrance and the Whitefield Windy Howe barrier entrance.

Our traffic management company will install wayfinding signage, 'No Waiting Cones' and 'Residents only' signage in key locations in the surrounding area.

To help reduce congestion at the end of the event, our traffic management company will be installing traffic lights on the exit from the visitor centre on Station Road and at the Abbey Arms crossroads.

We will have a CROW exclusion order in place which removes the public right of access into the area of forest surrounding the concert site while the event is taking place. Notices will be placed on the site prior to, and during, the concerts to inform the public.

A local resident number (01606 633 034) will be available on the evenings of the concerts from 5pm until approximately midnight to report any incidents or concerns. Please use this number rather than any other numbers or direct contacts you may have to ensure we can answer your call and respond in the most appropriate way. Sound checks

As with all music events it is necessary for sound checks to take place prior to the live performance. We will do our best to ensure that the sound checks do not take longer than necessary.

PA system tests will take place on the day before the concerts between 10am and 8pm. On show days, tests and sound checks will take place between 10am and 5pm. These times will vary according to when the band arrives and is set-up on stage.
